(The time to put paddles away)



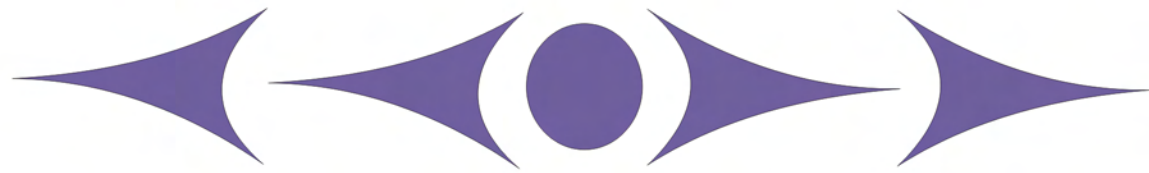

turn colour)



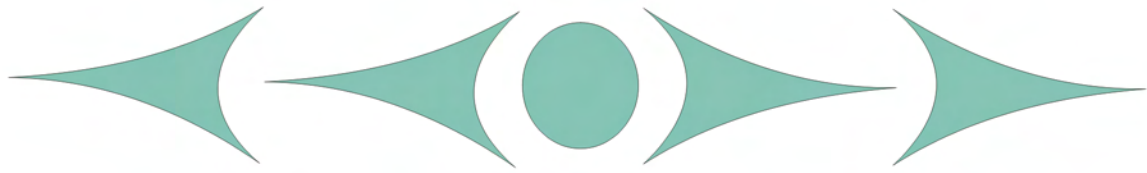

the short month)

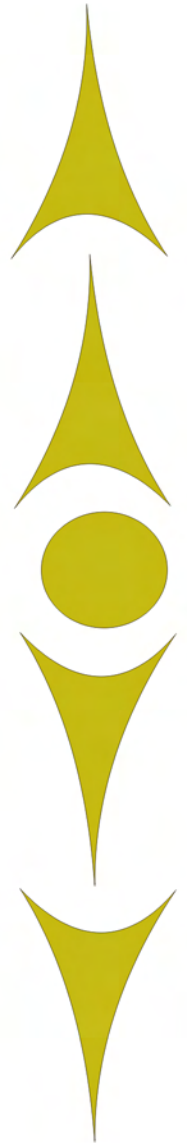
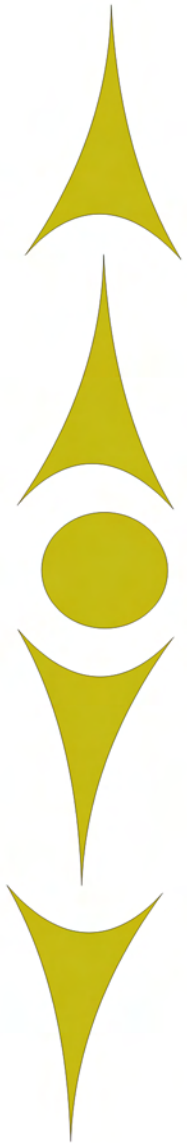

fly in V formation)



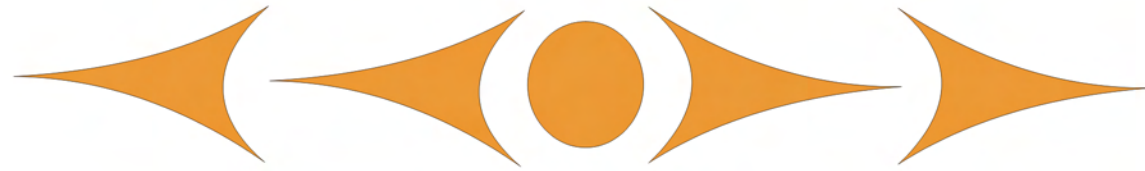
